



CCTV Policy

Objective of policy

The objective of this policy is to regulate the use of closed-circuit television and its associated technology by Deerpark Tennis Club.

Scope of policy

This policy applies to all Club members, visitors and contractors and relates to the location and use of CCTV.

Policy

The Club employs external CCTV for the purpose of enhancing security of the building, its facilities and associated equipment to act as a deterrent to and aid in the investigation of the other crimes such as theft and vandalism, and to enable the Club discharge its duty of care to both members and the public.

The use of CCTV must be legal, ethical and professional and its use for any other purposes is prohibited. Information stored will only be done so in line with the Club's Data Protection Policy and the Data protection section below.

Information obtained through CCTV may only be released with the authorisation of the Data Controller following consultation with the Club Chairperson.

Location of CCTV

Cameras are located to capture the following areas:

- Courts 1 & 2
- Courts 3 & 4
- Courts 5 & 6
- Main gate to upper courts
- Main gate to lower courts
- Walkway to lower courts

Data protection

All personal data recorded and stored is governed by the Club's Data Protection Policy and Irish legislation. All personal data recorded by the CCTV system will be retained for a maximum of 28 days after which it will be deleted unless required as part of a criminal investigation or court proceedings or other bona fide use as approved by the Club Committee.
